



ORDINANCE NO. 2010-1201

**AN ORDINANCE LEVYING TAXES FOR ALL TOWNSHIP
PURPOSES FOR CITY OF CHAMPAIGN TOWNSHIP,
CHAMPAIGN COUNTY, ILLINOIS
FOR THE TAX YEAR 2010, COLLECTIBLE IN 2011**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE CITY OF
CHAMPAIGN TOWNSHIP, CHAMPAIGN COUNTY, ILLINOIS, as follows:

Section 1. That the sum of five hundred and eighty four thousand, seven hundred and ninety eight dollars and no cents (\$584,798.00) is hereby levied upon all property subject to taxation within the Township as that property is assessed and equalized, in order to meet and defray all the necessary expenses and liabilities of the Township as required by statute or voted by the people in accordance with the law for such purposes as:

General Town Fund
General Assistance Fund
Social Security Fund
Illinois Municipal Retirement Fund

for the year 2011

Section 2. That the amount levied for each object and purpose shall be as follows:

Section 3. That the Town Clerk shall make and file with the County Clerk of said County of Champaign, on or before the last Tuesday of December 2009, a duly certified copy of this Ordinance and a certification by the Supervisor regarding the Truth in Taxation Act.

Section 4. That if any section, subdivision, or sentence of this Ordinance shall for any reason be held invalid or be unconstitutional, such finding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portion of this Ordinance.

Section 5. That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect after its adoption, as provided by law.

Section 6. That the Town Clerk is hereby directed to send a copy of this Ordinance to Pamela K. Borowski, Supervisor of the City of Champaign Township, and to Frederick Stavins, Township Attorney.
