ORDINANCE NO. 2013-1201

AN ORDINANCE LEVYING TAXES FOR ALL TOWNSHIP PURPOSES FOR CITY OF CHAMPAIGN TOWNSHIP, CHAMPAIGN COUNTY, ILLINOIS FOR THE TAX YEAR 2013, COLLECTIBLE IN 2014

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE CITY OF CHAMPAIGN TOWNSHIP, CHAMPAIGN COUNTY, ILLINOIS, as follows:

Section 1. That the sum of five hundred and eighty one thousand, ten dollars and no cents (\$581,010) is hereby levied upon all property subject to taxation with the Township as that property is assessed and equalized, in order to meet and defray all the necessary expenses and liabilities of the Township as required by statute or voted by the people in accordance with the law for such purposes as:

For the year 2014.
