ORDINANCE 2009-1201

AN ORDINANCE LEVYING TAXES FOR ALL TOWNSHIP PURPOSES FOR THE CITY OF CHAMPAIGN TOWNSHIP, CHAMPAIGN COUNTY, ILLINOIS, FOR THE TAX YEAR 2009, COLLECTIBLE IN 2010

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE CITY OF CHAMPAIGN TOWNSHIP, CHAMPAIGN COUNTY, ILLINOIS, as follows:

Section 1. That the sum of five hundred and sixty thousand, four hundred and thirteen dollars and no cents (560,413.00) is hereby levied upon all property subject to taxation within the Township as that property is assessed and equalized, in order to meet and defray all the necessary expenses and liabilities of the Township as required by statute or voted by the people in accordance with the law for such purposes:

General Town Fund
General Assistance Fund
Illinois Municipal Retirement Fund
Social Security Fund

for the year 2009.

Section 3. That the town clerk shall make and file with the county clerk of said County of Champaign, on or before the last Tuesday of December 2009, a duly certified copy of this ordinance and certification by the supervisor regarding the Truth in Taxation Act.

Section 4. That if any section, subdivision, or sentence of this ordinance shall for any reason be held invalid or be unconstitutional, such finding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portion of this ordinance.

Section 5. That this ordinance shall be in full force and effect after its adoption, as provided by law.

Section 6. That the town clerk is hereby directed to send a copy of this ordinance to Pamela K. Borowski, Supervisor of the City of Champaign Township, and to Frederick Stavins, Township Attorney.

ADOPTED this 1st day of December 2009, pursuant to a roll call vote by the Board of Trustees of the City of Champaign Township, Champaign County, Illinois.
