

ORDINANCE NO. 2014-1201

**AN ORDINANCE LEVYING TAXES FOR ALL TOWNSHIP PURPOSES FOR CITY OF CHAMPAIGN TOWNSHIP,
CHAMPAIGN COUNTY, ILLINOIS FOR THE TAX YEAR 2014, COLLECTIBLE IN 2015**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE CITY OF CHAMPAIGN TOWNSHIP,
CHAMPAIGN COUNTY, ILLINOIS, as follows:

Section 1. That the sum of five hundred ninety-eight thousand, three hundred sixty-eight dollars and no cents (\$598,368) is hereby levied upon all property subject to taxation with the Township as that property is assessed and equalized, in order to meet and defray all the necessary expenses and liabilities of the Township as required by statute or voted by the people in accordance with the law for such purposes as:

- General Town Fund
- General Assistance Fund
- Social Security Fund
- Illinois Municipal Retirement Fund

For the year 2015.

Section 2. That the amount levied for each object and purpose shall be as follows:

Section 5. That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect after its adoption, as provided by law.
