TOWN BOARD AND TOWNSHIP SUPERVISOR'S COMMENT:


Supervisor Quarnstrom noted the Youth Program began today and will continue through August 27, 2016. He thanked Information Technologies for all their efforts including ensuring audio-visual operation. Regarding Social Services in the community, Supervisor Quarnstrom noted central intake, which provides a central location for those in need in the community to receive direction about resources, is tied with the Emergency

Family Shelter which is now open. The Township has started a partnership with the Shelter and are beginning to take referrals for families currently in the Shelter, looking to move into the City of Champaign, to provide resources for them both financial and otherwise. A great demand for the shelter is anticipated, with it being one of the only shelters in the community because of budget constraints; and the Shelter will help provide a great need in the community.

NEXT MEETING: Chairperson Feinen noted the next meeting would be the Regular Town Meeting of August 2, 2016.
