Total expenditures for the month of August 2017 were \$51,352.93. Supervisor Quarnstrom noted no remarkable expenditures, but there had been an increase in the number of General Assistance cases. Board Member Beck requested, reports in the future, to see what assistance goes towards to assist with planning. Board Member Stock, seconded by Board Member Kyles, moved to accept and place on file the summary of expenditures. A voice vote was taken; all voted yes. Motion carried.


AUDIENCE PARTICIPATION: None
