BOARD OF TRUSTEES**

DATE: November 10, 2020

Pursuant to 5 ILCS 120/7(e), which suspends the requirement of the Illinois Open Meetings Act requiring in-person attendance by members of a public body during the duration of the Gubernatorial Disaster Proclamation, attendance by all Township/Council Members, Township Supervisor, and Township Clerk will be electronic via an online meeting platform.

The members of the Township were not physically present for the October 6, 2020 Monthly Township Meeting but instead participated in the meeting through audio or audio/video access using a virtual meeting platform.

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APPROVAL OF MINUTES:

October 6, 2020 Regular Township Meeting

Board Member Stock, seconded by Board Member Gladney, moved to approve the minutes. There was no Board Member discussion. A roll-call vote was taken; all voted yes. Motion carried.

CORRESPONDENCE: None

APPROVAL OF SUMMARY OF CHECKS WRITTEN – ALL FUNDS, SEPTEMBER 2020: September showed the total for the Town Fund was \$68,062.82; General Assistance was \$28,788.29; IMRF was \$7,896.11; and the Social Security Fund was \$1,074.33. Total expenditures for the month of September 2020 were \$105,821.55. Board Member Stock, seconded by Board Member Gladney, moved to approve the

work done by the Township, but with many in need in the community and the pandemic, he would recommend the 0% increase the first year. A roll-call vote was taken on the motion to amend the Ordinance; all voted no. Motion to amend failed. Chairperson Feinen called for any audience comments regarding the original motion; there were no hands raised to provide input. There were no comments by Board Members in relation to the original motion. A roll-call vote was taken on the motion to adopt the compensation ordinance; all voted yes. Motion carried.

AUDIENCE PARTICIPATION: Board Member Bruno noted no hands were raised to provide public comment.

TOWN BOARD AND TOWNSHIP SUPERVISOR'S COMMENT: There were no comments by Town Board Members; and no comments by Supervisor Quarnstrom.

NEXT MEETING: Chairperson Feinen noted the next Regular Meeting date of December 1, 2020.

ADJOURNMENT: Board Member Stock, seconded by Board Member Gladney, moved to adjourn. A roll-call vote was taken; all voted yes. Motion carried.
