**TOWN OF THE CITY OF CHAMPAIGN
BOARD OF TRUSTEES**

DATE: December 1, 2020

Pursuant to 5 ILCS 120/7(e), which suspends the requirement of the Illinois Open Meetings Act requiring in-person attendance by members of a public body during the duration of the Gubernatorial Disaster Proclamation, attendance by all Township/Council Members, Township Supervisor, and Township Clerk will be electronic via an online meeting platform.

The members of the Township were not physically present for the December 1, 2020 Monthly Township Meeting but instead participated in the meeting through audio or audio/video access using a virtual meeting platform.

CALL TO ORDER: Chairperson Feinen called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m.

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APPROVAL OF MINUTES:

November 10, 2020 Regular Township Meeting

Board Member Stock, seconded by Board Member Gladney, moved to approve the minutes. There was no Board Member discussion. A roll-call vote was taken; all voted yes. Motion carried.

CORRESPONDENCE: None

APPROVAL OF SUMMARY OF CHECKS WRITTEN – ALL FUNDS, OCTOBER 2020: October showed the total for the Town Fund was \$82,244.55; General Assistance

was \$32,155.42; IMRF was \$7,961.61; and the Social Security Fund was \$1,658.46. Total expenditures for the month of October 2020 were \$124,020.04. Board Member Stock, seconded by Board Member Gladney, moved to approve the expenditures and place them on file. There was no discussion by Board Members. A roll-call vote was taken; all voted yes. Motion carried.

PUBLIC HEARING: TOWNSHIP LEVY:

The public hearing was opened at 7:02 p.m. After a brief explanation of the public hearing by Chairperson Feinen, the public was invited to speak. There were no hands raised by the public to speak. The hearing was closed at 7:03 p.m.

ACTION ON ORDINANCES AND RESOLUTIONS:

Passed 2020-1201 “An Ordinance Levying
Taxes For All Township Purposes
For The City Of Champaign Township,
Champaign County, Illinois For The
Tax Year 2020, Collectible In 2021”

Tax Levy Amount \$762,711
Estimated Assessed Valuation \$1,899,140.026

Board Member Stock, seconded by Board Member Gladney, moved to adopt the Ordinance. Supervisor Quarnstrom noted the Ordinance codifies the Township levy; the estimated levy was approved last month; and the levy notice was published in the News-Gazette and all statutory requirements have been met. There were no technical questions by Board Members; and no hands raised by the public to provide input. A roll-call vote was taken on the motion to adopt the Ordinance; all voted yes. Motion carried.

Passed 2020-1202 “An Ordinance Amending
The Annual Budget For The Township
General Assistance Fund”

Board Member Stock, seconded by Board Member Gladney, moved to adopt the Ordinance. After a brief explanation of the Ordinance by Chairperson Feinen, there were no technical questions by Board Members; and no hands raised by the public to provide input. Supervisor Quarnstrom noted the Township executed a subrecipient agreement to receive Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funds to assist the CU@Work program for beautification, Prosperity Gardens and the mobile market, and working to assist the homeless. The \$22,559 would be used for the program. There were no Board Member comments. A roll-call vote was taken on the motion to adopt the Ordinance; all voted yes. Motion carried.

Passed 2020-1203 “An Ordinance Amending
The Annual Budget For The Township
General Fund”

Board Member Stock, seconded by Board Member Gladney, moved to adopt the Ordinance. After a brief explanation of the Ordinance by Chairperson Feinen, there were no technical questions by Board Members. There was a raised hand from the audience, Anita Ung, Champaign, but the member noted her comments were intended for the City. There were no comments from Board Members. Supervisor Quarnstrom noted the \$94,800 was received from the Local Coronavirus Urgent Remediation Emergency Support Program (CURES) funding to offset costs associated with COVID and Township operations. A roll-call vote was taken on the motion to adopt the Ordinance; all voted yes. Motion carried.

FY 19-20 AUDIT REPORT:

Board Member Stock, seconded by Board Member Gladney, moved to accept the audit and place it on file. Supervisor Quarnstrom noted the audit had been placed on the Township web site available for public viewing; there were no audit findings; and the audit is complete. There were no technical questions by Board Members; and no hands raised by the public to provide input. There were no comments by Board Members. A roll-call vote was taken to accept the audit report and place it on file; all voted yes. Motion carried.

AUDIENCE PARTICIPATION: Board Member Bruno noted no hands were raised to provide public comment.

TOWN BOARD AND TOWNSHIP SUPERVISOR'S COMMENT: There were no comments by Town Board Members; and no comments by Supervisor Quarnstrom.

NEXT MEETING: Chairperson Feinen noted the next Regular Meeting date of January 5, 2021.

ADJOURNMENT: Board Member Stock, seconded by Board Member Gladney, moved to adjourn. A roll-call vote was taken; all voted yes. Motion carried.
