APPROVAL OF MINUTES:

May 4, 2021 Regular Township Meeting

Board Member Pianfetti, seconded by Board Member Gladney, moved to approve the minutes. There was no Board Member discussion. A roll-call vote was taken; all voted yes. Motion carried.

PUBLIC HEARING – ANNUAL BUDGET: Chairperson Feinen gave a brief explanation of the purpose of the public hearing, opening the public hearing at 7:02 p.m. and invited the public to speak. No one spoke. The public hearing was closed at 7:03 p.m.

APPROVAL OF SUMMARY OF CHECKS WRITTEN – ALL FUNDS, APRIL 2021: April showed the total for the Town Fund was \$87,340.56; General Assistance was \$77,795.38; IMRF was \$8,193.15; and the Social Security Fund was \$1,770.45. Total expenditures for the month of April 2021 were \$175,099.54. Board Member Pianfetti, seconded by Board Member Gladney, moved to approve the expenditures, and place them on file. There was no discussion by Board Members. A roll-call vote was taken; all voted yes. Motion carried.

ORDINANCES AND RESOLUTIONS:

Passed 2021-0601 “An Ordinance Adopting
The Annual Budget and Appropriation
Ordinance”

Board Member Pianfetti, seconded by Board Member Gladney, moved to adopt the Ordinance. Supervisor Quarnstrom noted the budget has been available for review for the past month and there has been no public comment. There was no discussion by Board Members. A roll-call vote was taken, all voted yes.

AUDIENCE PARTICIPATION: None

TOWN BOARD AND TOWNSHIP SUPERVISOR’S COMMENT: There were no comments by Town Board Members. Supervisor Quarnstrom noted capacity had been reached with COVID housing funds providing approximately \$500,000 in mortgage housing and rental assistance, and working with partners for additional funding, and post moratorium funds; CU@Work selling fresh vegetables at the Champaign Farmer’s Market; architect working to remodel the former police evidence building, used for Prosperity Gardens; working to assist with homeless issues in the community with the closure of the CU at Home homeless shelter, with special thanks to the Neighborhood Services Department for their assistance; and noted assistance applications are now available on line in Spanish and working to make them available in French.

NEXT MEETING: Chairperson Feinen noted the next Regular Meeting date of July 6, 2021 for the Regular Township meeting.

ADJOURNMENT: Board Member Pianfetti, seconded by Board Member Gladney, moved to adjourn. A roll-call vote was taken; all voted yes. Motion carried.
