APPROVAL OF SUMMARY OF EXPENDITURES – ALL FUNDS, SEPTEMBER 2022: September showed the total for the Town Fund was \$95,487.81; General Assistance was \$31,224.24; IMRF was \$7,861.92; and the Social Security Fund was \$1,778.27. Total expenditures for the month of September 2022 were \$136,352.24. Board Member Pianfetti, seconded by Board Member Gladney, moved to approve the expenditures, and place them on file. A voice vote was taken; all voted yes. Motion carried.

### FY 22-23 1<sup>ST</sup> QUARTER REPORT:

Supervisor Quarnstrom acknowledged Deputy Supervisor Vanantwerp for her work to enhance the report and make it more visually appealing. Board Member Pianfetti, seconded by Board Member Gladney, moved to approve the 1<sup>st</sup> Quarter Report. A voice vote was taken; all voted yes. Motion carried.
