APPROVAL OF MINUTES:

- November 1, 2023, Regular Township Meeting

Board Member Pianfetti, seconded by Board Member Gladney, moved to approve the minutes. There was no Board Member discussion. A voice vote was taken; all voted yes. Motion carried.

APPROVAL OF SUMMARY OF EXPENDITURES – ALL FUNDS, OCTOBER 2023:

October showed the total for the Town Fund was \$212,458.00; General Assistance was \$34,042.35; Shelter Fund was \$14,299.84; Social Security Fund was \$1,171.58; and IMRF was \$30,284.28. Total expenditures for the month of October 2023 were \$292,256.05. Board Member Pianfetti, seconded by Board Member Gladney, moved to approve the expenditures, and place them on file. A voice vote was taken; all voted yes. Motion carried.

PUBLIC HEARING: TOWNSHIP LEVY

The public hearing was opened at 7:02 p.m. After a brief explanation of the public hearing by Chairperson Feinen, the public was invited to speak. No one spoke. The hearing was closed at 7:03 p.m.

ORDINANCES AND RESOLUTIONS:

Passed 2023-1201 “An Ordinance levying taxes for all Township purposes for the City of Champaign Township, Champaign County, Illinois for the tax year 2023, collectible in 2024”

Board Member Pianfetti, seconded by Board Member Gladney, moved to adopt the Ordinance. Supervisor Quarnstrom confirmed the levy rate and noted the increase was reflective of new construction and increased property values. A roll-call vote was taken; all voted yes. Motion carried.

Passed 2023-1202 “A Resolution Approving Time Off Accrual in the Personnel Policy Manual”

Board Member Pianfetti, seconded by Board Member Gladney, moved to adopt the Resolution. Supervisor Quarnstrom noted the revision to the Personnel Policy Manual was needed to comply with the Paid Leave for All Workers Act. A roll-call vote was taken; all voted yes. Motion carried.
