**SUMMARY OF EXPENDITURES – ALL FUNDS, DECEMBER 2025:**

December showed the total for the Town Fund was \$220,617.19; General Assistance was \$31,822.72; Shelter Fund was \$24,602.92; IMRF was \$12,815.36; and the Social Security Fund was \$846.74. Total expenditures for the month of December 2025 were \$290,704.93. Board Member Pianfetti, seconded by Board Member Gladney, moved to approve the expenditures, and place them on file. There was no discussion by Board Members. A voice vote was taken; all voted yes. Motion carried.

STRIDES SHELTER UPDATE:

Board Member Pianfetti, seconded by Board Member Gladney, moved to place the report on file. Supervisor Murray noted staff continues to work on the last month of the revision plan, which will result in changes to the reports provided to the Town Board including monthly and quarterly reporting broken out between Strides and the Township, and operations data for all of the Township.

Board Members comments included short term vs. long term plan; community partner interest; number of individuals served; overflow shelter; change of location for the shelter; increase of outside foot traffic if overflow shelter is closed; additional funding needed to get through the current fiscal year; City and other governmental agency financial contributions; and timeline for alternative plan.

Supervisor Murray further noted she will be reaching out to Board Members to schedule preliminary information exchange meetings soon.

A voice vote was taken; all voted yes. Motion carried.

Budget Amendment – Chairperson Feinen gave a brief explanation of the purpose of the public hearing, opened the public hearing at 7:22 p.m. and invited the public to speak. No members of the audience spoke. The public hearing was closed at 7:23 p.m.
